Following the publication of the national NHS Long Term Plan, which sets out how the NHS will improve care for patients over the next ten years, CCGs in the Black Country and West Birmingham are planning improvements to primary care services and would like to hear the views of local people.

We recognise that Primary Care provides the first point of contact for many people. The main source of primary care is general practice, which is the care and treatment delivered from doctors' surgeries in local communities.

The views of members of the public, patients, doctors, nurses and other healthcare professionals are being used to develop a strategy for the future of primary care services to ensure improved access, continuity and coordination of care for local people.

We are hosting events across the Black Country and West Birmingham to share the key elements of this strategy with local people. We want to check that we are in the right place, that we are not missing anything important and to confirm that the strategy will meet local need.
