

Sarah's Law Disclosure Requests have gone online!


What is Sarah's Law?

Sarah's Law is the Child Sex Offender Disclosure scheme, which allows anyone to formally ask the police if someone who has access to a child has a child sexual offences record

When did it go live?



Go Live for online applications was Thursday 20th June 2019



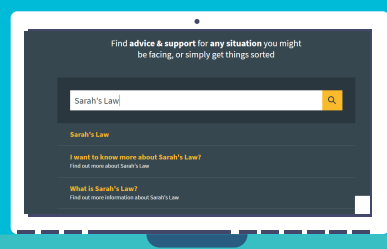
Since the 20th June 2019, 57% of the requests received have been via our online channel!
